

Community Council Report – July ‘13

Apologies.

During the month up to 24th of June '13, (submitted early due to my taking holidays), there were 30 calls to the area, the majority of these being of a routine nature. Of these there were:

5 Speed/Road checks – resulting in 3 offences being detected.

10 Reports of animals on the roads. That time of year again.

Other Matters:

On the 5th of June there was a report of anti-social behaviour over night, 4th/5th, in the grounds of the primary school. If anyone is aware of issues at the school that give rise to concerns, please inform the police as soon as possible.

On the 6th June a report was received that between 18th and 21st of May, app 600 litres of domestic heating oil has been stolen from the fuel tank located in the garden of a property in Earlston Road, Stow. This only came to light when the heating went off and an engineer attended and found the tank empty.

On the 13th of June a report was received that over night, 12th/13th June another quad bike was stolen from Stagehall Farm.

Again on the 13th a report was received that overnight 12th/13th, an address in Manor Park, Stow, had the garage door forced open. Nothing was taken.

On the 14th of June a report was received that between the 12th & 14th June a small electric fencing supply unit was stolen from a field near to the bridge over the river in Station Road, Stow. The supply unit is a black square box, with red leads, a black lead and an earth lead coming out of the unit. The unit has 'Rutland Electric Shepherd 350' written in green on its face.

If anyone has any information relating to above or saw or heard anything suspicious at the relevant times, please contact the police as soon as possible.

As is evident from the above there are undesirable elements frequenting the area so please be alert and as always, please report anything suspicious no matter how apparently insignificant, as soon as possible, to give us the best chance of deterring and detecting crime. Remember the motto:
